As well as meeting with your child's class teacher, there is an option to book a second interview with Robyn Poulden, Learning Support Coordinator, if your child is currently, or has previously attended Learning Support.

1. Are there any parts of the report that need further explanation?
2. What are the areas identified for improvement?
3. What are the positive areas of growth identified by the class teacher?
